

## Beet pulp in *Pellets*

Beet pulp or strips are a by-product left over from the industrial processing of sugar beets.

They are used by farmers, either dried or in the moist state, as livestock feeds in all countries where cultivation of sugar beet is widespread.

In cattle rations, fresh-pressed or ensiled beet pulp should be mixed with other dry feeds such as hay, bran, straw or chaff.

It is also essential to add concentrated feeds and adequate mineral and vitamin supplements to obtain a balanced ration.
